Ski Jacket & Legs or Ski Suit (Pretty important!)	
Mid layer thermal-fleeces - Roll or Zip neck tops - (we suggest 3 or 4)	
Thermal Underwear (Need to keep everything warm!)	
Ski Gloves (Essential, unless you want your hands to freeze of course)	
Ski Socks (we suggest 3 or 4)	
Ski Hat (Try and get a really cool one, with bobbles, and lots of colour in case you get lost in the snow!)	
Sun cream /Lip balm (unless you are going for the goggle face look)	
Goggles and Sunglasses (a spec retainer is also very useful)	
Snow Boots (you might sink otherwise!)	
Ski Clip (holds skis together and useful to identify hire skis with a unique mark)	
Ski Pass Holder (so you don't lose it)	
Bum Bag or Small Rucksack (to put some snacks and ski pass in)	
Helmet (especially for children)	
Necker (not essential but so useful extra for warmth)	
Ski equipment, skis, poles, board, boots unless hiring (Essential unless you are going to run down the slopes?)
